2007 OSSLT RESULTS

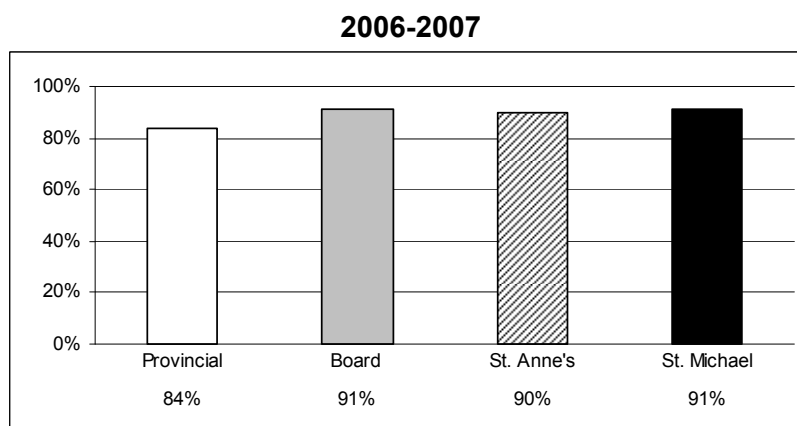
Information for Parents and Guardians

In March 2007, the students of St. Anne's Catholic Secondary School and St. Michael Catholic Secondary School participated in the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test. All students will receive a complete analysis of their achievement. The provincial, board, and school results are listed below.

For the fifth consecutive year, the students of our secondary schools have performed above the provincial average. However, we are committed to improved performance. To achieve this:

- Our School-Based Literacy Committees have analyzed the results and have developed strategies to achieve improved student performance.
- These committees will continue to provide support and share strategies with teachers in the area of effective literacy instruction.
- These committees will also provide strategies for students who are unsuccessful on the Literacy Test, including the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Course. Students may enroll in this full-credit English course, which will be offered at both secondary schools in 2007-08. Students in our secondary schools have a 98% success rate in this course.
- Each school will continue to implement its School Improvement Plan, which emphasizes strategies to improve all students' literacy capabilities.
